WHAT TO BRING

Groups need to supply their own fishing gear. We have included a recommended equipment list below. There are a couple of tackle shops in Yeppoon, and passengers travelling by road through Rockhampton will drive past Barra Jacks Tackle World.

We recommend The Secret Spot, Charles St, Yeppoon. Ph 07 49392697. (They can organise all you tackle needs for your trip and offers a pay at the end service for passengers flying.)

We supply pilchards and squid. Alternative or BYO bait can be arranged prior to your trip. Catch is filleted or left whole, as you desire, and frozen to -30°C. Airport foam eskies, and freight can all be organised for transportation of your catch home.

Basic Items

Personal toiletries and medication. Preferably environmentally friendly.

Sunscreen, seasickness tablets, band-aids

Wide brimmed hat/long sleeved light shirt

Waterproof and warm jumper

DVDs/music/camera

Cheap polarised sunglasses

Ear plugs

Old clothes for fishing and one good set of clothes for the evening

Sneakers or wetsuit boots

BASIC EQUIPMENT LIST

Where possible, each passenger should pack their day-to-day fishing gear in a round 20L bucket with lid for safe storage during the trip. Spare tackle can be kept in cabins and bought up to back deck is required.

Please note we recommend 40lb mono/braid line or stronger for fishing the Swain Reef

Fishing gear for main boat

Rods of your choice setup for trolling and drifting

Assorted lures–high speed ones are best

Balloons for use as floaters

Piano wire/leader wire (100 – 140lb)

80 – 100lb leader line

40 – 80lb braid or mono

Knife

De Hooker (optional)

Gloves or finger stalls made from electrical tape or tyre inner tube

Lanyard for attaching rod to vessel

Asst Sinkers including large snapper leads

Additional gear for dories

Light eggbeater style rod–good for casting

Hand line 60 -80lb –optional

Line–minimum 40lb mono, braid tends to chaff

Hooks–6 – 9/0s (Mustad saltwater fliers work great)

small tackle box

foam cushions half inch thick provides bit of extra padding in the Dory as the seats are

Small tackle box, small drink esky, thin foam cushion.

Sinkers–teardrop size 12, ball size 10 and 8, bean size 6 and 4, pea size 2

Recommended lures for trolling

6 inch Smith Jig–red, white and silver

Strike Zone Predator 6 inch

Halco Crazy Deep 7m Laser Pro - red and white

Halco Max 130 80gr – chrome pink

Lively Lures 7in Mack Bait

Big trembler lures – any make

All trolling lures should be 4 - 8in long

Red/white, pink, blue, blue metallic and taipan colours seem to work best. Bibs are okay for dories but not suited for back deck fishing.
